**PART II RECOMMENDED PRACTICE FOR
COLD WEATHER CONCRETING**

1. SCOPE

1.1 This code deals with the procedure and precautions to be observed while concreting in cold weather so as to minimize the detrimental effect of cold weather on concreting in general types of construction, such as buildings, bridges, highways, pavements and other similar structures.

NOTE – All requirements of IS : 456-1978† and IS: 1343-1980‡ in so far as they apply shall be deemed to form part of this code except where otherwise laid down in this code.
