FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 30 June 1976, after the draft finalized by the Animal Housing and Equipment Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Artificial Insemination (AI) is being increasingly used for improving genetic potentialities of the livestock in the country. This necessitates application of properly cleaned and sterilized AI equipment and material to help in controlling spread of diseases from one animal to the other. This Indian Standard has been formulated to provide guidelines on efficient cleaning and sterilization of equipment and material used in AI work.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This code provides guidelines for cleaning and sterilization of equipment and material used for processing, handling and transport of semen; and for Artificial Insemination (AI) and allied work.
