**SPECIFICATION FOR
STEEL FOLDING COTS**

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 27 February 1978, after the draft finalized by the Furniture Sectional Committee had been approved by the Civil Engineering Division Council.

0.2 The fast changing developments and innovations in designs have brought new concepts in designing furniture, where shortage of living space is effectively solved by such furniture items having folding arrangements so that these could be stored in folding condition while not in use. The popularity of folding cot further increases due to the fact that large quantities of such cots can be stored and transported with comparative ease.

0.3 This standard contains clause 9.1 which requires the purchaser to supply certain technical information at the time of placing orders.

0.4 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated expressing the result of a test or analysis, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS : 2-1960*. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard covers requirements of materials, dimensions, construction and finish of steel folding cots.
