FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 25 August 1980, after the draft finalized by the Horticultural Equipment Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Power lawn mowers are commonly used for cutting grass in lawns and are the answer to mow large lawns fast. Power lawn mower gives the lawn a carpet-smooth turf and efficiently handles any mowing job, such as a park, playground, golf court and institutional grounds.

0.3 Power lawn mowers have either cylinder (reel) type or rotary type cutting mechanism. It is intended to issue separate Indian Standards covering the requirements of these two basic types.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard specifies material, constructional and other requirements for pedestrian-controlled cylinder power lawn mowers.

NOTE — This standard does not cover the requirements relating to tractor-operated power lawn mowers.
