CANNED SPINACH

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 28 April 1981, after the draft finalized by the Fruits and Vegetables Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 Canned spinach is the product prepared from mature spinach of suitable varieties. They are cleaned and packed in brine. They are processed in appropriate manner before and after being sealed in containers so as to prevent spoilage.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements for spinach (*Spinacia oleracea* Linn.) canned in brine.
