 ${\bf 1.1}$ This standard (Part I) covers the definition of in relation to tillage and intercultivation equipment. General

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard (Part I) was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 27 April 1981, after the draft finalized by the Soil Working Equipment Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

0.2 With the increasing scope of farm mechanization, a large number of tillage and intercultivation equipment are being designed, developed, manufactured and used in the country. The need was, therefore, felt for a comprehensive glossary which would provide authentic definitions of the terms used in respect of such equipment. It is hoped that this glossary would serve as a useful reference.

0.3 This standard is being published in two parts. Part I covers the definitions of general terms; the other Part (Part II) covers the definitions of terms relating to equipment.
