SPECIFICATION FOR PARBOILED RICE BRAN
AS LIVESTOCK FEED INGREDIENT

FOREWORD

0.1 This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 30 June 1981, after the draft finalized by the Annual Feeds Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council,

0.2 Considerable amount of parboiled rice bran is being produced in the country. The Committee responsible for formulation of this standard felt that a separate standard be brought to cover its various requirements which are essentially at variance With raw rice bran. It is recommended that the product shall not contain more than 30 parts per billion of aflatoxins.

0.3 Two Indian Standards (IS : 3593-1979* and IS : 3648-1975†) covering requirements for solvent extracted nee bran as livestock feed ingredient and rice bran as livestock feed Ingredient have been issued separately.

0.4 For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated expressing the result of a test or analysis, shall be rounded off In accordance With IS : 2-1960‡. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard prescribes the requirements and the methods of sampling and test for parboiled rice bran for use as an ingredient in livestock feed.
