TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR POWER TAKE-OFF PULLEY FOR AGRICULTURAL TRACTORS WITH TYPE 1 PTO SHAFT

FOREWORD

- **0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standard, Institution on 31 July 1981, after the draft finalized by the Agricultural Tractors and Power. Tillers Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council
- **0.2** Power take-off (PTO) pulleys arc being used for transmitting power from tractors to the belt-pulley operated agricultural equipment, such as power thresher, chaff cutter and pump sets. The dimensions and quality of indigenously made pulley vary considerably A need was, therefore, felt to prepare Indian Standard on the subject to help the manufacturers m production of quality pulleys.
- **0.3** Three type, of PTO are covered In IS: 4931-1977 However, presently mostly Type 1, PTO covered in IS: 4931-1977*, is being used in indigenous tractors. Hence in this standard, the dimensions relating to pulleys used in relation to Type 1 PTO have been included. As and when the dimensions and other details of pulleys for type 2 and 3 PTO are available, the same would be incorporated in this standard.
- **0.4** In the preparation of this standard, assistance has been derived from Mis Mahmdra and Mahmdra Limited (International Tractor Division), Bombay and Tractor Training and Testing Station (Ministry of Agriculture). Budm
- **0.5** For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is completed with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test or analysis, shall be rounded off m accordance with IS: 2 1960†. The number of significant place, retained 10 the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value m this standard.

1. SCOPE

1.1 This standard covers dimensions, safety and other requirements and performance test for power take-off pulley suitable for Type 1 PTO of agricultural tractors.
