Indian Standard PICTORIAL SURFACE PREPARATION STANDARDS FOR PAINTING OF STEEL SURFACES

1. SCOPE

- 1.1 This standard specifies four different grades of rust (A, B, C and D) developed on the surface of steel, and recommends preparation of these rust grades to either two grades of surface preparation (St 2 and St 3) when scraping and wire brushing is employed or four grades of surface' preparation (Sa 1, Sa 2, Sa $2\frac{1}{2}$ and Sa 3) when blast cleaning is employed.
- **1.1.1** The recommended rust and preparation grades are' defined by colour prints representing a full scale view of part of the surface.

NOTE — The cleaning techniques to be adopted for achieving the different grades of surface preparation has been covered in IS: 1477 (Part I)-1971†.
