## (PREVIEW) Indian Standard CODE OF HYGIENIC CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF CUT-FRUITS, FRUIT JUICE AND FRUIT SALAD

## FOREWORD

**0.1** This Indian Standard was adopted by the Indian Standards Institution on 23 July 1976, after the draft finalized by the Food Hygiene, Sampling and Analysis Sectional Committee had been approved by the Agricultural and Food Products Division Council.

**0.2** Stalls for sale of cut-fruits, fruit juice and fruit salad are found in almost all important streets in the cities. It has been often observed that these stalls are not properly maintained and there is considerable scope for improving their hygienic conditions. Unless proper hygienic norms are adopted. Unless proper hygienic norms are adopted, the consumption of such cut-fruits, fruit juice and fruit salad from these stalls may be a potential health hazard to the consumers. This standard provides guidelines in maintaining optimum hygienic conditions in these stalls.

## **1 SCOPE**

**1.1** The code lays down hygienic conditions for establishing and maintaining stalls for sale of cut-fruits, fruit juice and fruit salad.
