Item 0 Welcome and Opening Remarks

Item 1 Confirmation of Minutes of the last Meeting

The committee formally confirmed the minutes of last meeting held on 02.11.2023.

Item 2 Scope and Composition of Committee

2.1 The committee noted the scope of work and recommended no change at present.

2.2 The committee noted its updated composition as given in Annex-1.

Item 3 Issues Arising out of Previous Meetings

3.1 Standard on BMX Bicycles

The committee noted that standard on BMX bicycles is on Gazette Notification stage.

3.2 Draft on E-Bicycles

Dr. Thakur informed the committee that DPIIT desire to bring out Quality Control Order related to E Bicycles and requested to expedite the publication of the standard. The committee deliberated and decided to wide circulate the draft for E bicycle for 30 days period.

3.3 Issues raised by UCPMA in last meeting:

Following issue raised by UCPMA during last meeting:

Issue	Deliberations	Decision in last meeting
 Dimensional Size of the Reflectors needs to be standardized - As ISO6742/2 mentions only the methods and the standardization on the quality perspective but does not include minimum dimensions required. Deviation of 20% from the standard photometric valueson mass production in ISO6742/2 and aligning along with standards of the reflectors by Economic Commission for Europe (ECE) E/ECE/324 & E/ECE/TRANS/505 - The reason is that in the process of Injection Moulding, there are lots of uncontrollable variables. 	 During the 28th meeting 1. Sh. Manjinder Singh informed that as per European Standards, 20% deviation is allowed in photometric tests. 2. Sh. Vishwas Mehta (R&D Center for Bicycles & Sewing Machines) was requested to share the study on range of values for OK reflectors with the panel. 3. The panel was directed to review the European standards and share their recommendations at the earliest with Member Secretary & other TED 16 committee members. Submission by R & D Centre for Bicycles and Sewing Machines Study on the reflectors carried out by R & D Centre for Bicycle and Sewing Machine, Ludhiana. "Data of 04 types of reflectors (Front-White, Rear-Red, and Side-Yellow & Pedal-Yellow) for the last one year was collected and analyzed. It was observedthat the difference in photometric values of the reflectors of the same lot is more than 20%." 	Sh Manjinder Singh updated the committee about the issue and the committee requested Sh Singh to formally submit revised draft within 1 month.

Item 4 Draft Standards/Amendments for Finalization

The committee discussed the comments received from Sh Pradeep Aggarwal on the draft of Bicycle- Mudguard. The committee the decided to refer the same to panel comprising R & D center, Hero Cycles, Citizen and requested them to invite Sh Aggarwal in discussion in next meeting so that the draft can be finalized.
