### NATIONAL FOREWORD

This draft Indian standard is an identical adoption of ISO 15553 : 2006 'Water quality — Isolation and identification of *Cryptosporidium* oocysts and *Giardia* cysts from water' issued by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

In reporting the results of a test or analysis made in accordance with this standard, if the final value, observed or calculated, is to be rounded off, it shall be done in accordance with IS 2: 2022 'Rules for rounding off numerical values (*second revision*)'.
