NATIONAL FOREWORD

This draft Indian Standard (Part 2) which is identical to ‘ISO/IEC 27050-2:2018 Information technology— Electronic discovery— Part 2: Guidance for governance and management of electronic discovery’ issued by the International Organization Standardization (ISO) and International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) will be adopted by the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) on the recommendations of the Information Systems Security And Privacy Sectional Committee and approval of the Electronics and Information Technology Division Council.

Part 3: Code of practice for electronic discovery

Part 4: Technical readiness

The text of ISO/IEC Standard may be approved as suitable for publication as an Indian Standard without deviations. Certain conventions and terminologies are, however, not identical to those used in Indian Standards. Attention is particularly drawn to the following:

- a) Wherever the words ‘International Standard’ appear referring to this standard, they should be read as ‘Indian Standard’, and
- b) Comma (,) has been used as a decimal marker while in Indian Standards, the current practice is to use a point (.) as the decimal marker.

In this adopted draft standard, reference appears to certain International Standards for which Indian Standards also exist. The corresponding Indian Standards, which are to be substituted in their respective places, are listed below along with their degree of equivalence for the editions indicated. For dated references, only the edition cited applies. For undated references, the latest edition of the referenced document (including any amendments) applies:

Scope of ISO/IEC 27050-2:2018 is as follows:

“This document provides guidance for technical and non-technical personnel at senior management levels within an organization, including those with responsibility for compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements, and industry standards.

It describes how such personnel can identify and take ownership of risks related to electronic discovery, set policy and achieve compliance with corresponding external and internal requirements. It also suggests how to produce such policies in a form which can inform process control. Furthermore, it provides guidance on how to implement and control electronic discovery in accordance with the policies.”
