#### NATIONAL FOREWORD

This Indian Standard which is identical with ISO 11901-5: 2021 'Tools for Pressing — Gas-Springs — Part 5: Safety Instructions for Gas-Springs' issued by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) will be adopted by the Bureau of Indian Standards on the recommendation of the Metal Forming Machines Sectional Committee and approval of the Production and General Engineering Division Council.

This Standard describes the safety requirements for gas springs in accordance with ISO 11901-1, ISO 11901-3 and ISO 11901-4 intended for use in press tool and their correct installation instructions.

This Indian Standard is published in five parts. The other parts in this series are:

- Part 1 General Specification
- Part 2 Specification of accessories
- Part 3 Gas spring with increased spring force and compact built height
- Part 4 Gas springs with increased spring force and same built height

The text of ISO standard has been approved as suitable for publication as an Indian Standard without deviations. Certain conventions are however not identical to those used in Indian Standards. Attention is particularly drawn to the following

- a) Wherever the words 'International Standard' appear referring to this standard, they should be read as 'Indian Standard'.
- b) Comma (,) has been used as a decimal marker while in Indian Standards, the current-practice is to use a point (.) as the decimal marker.

The standard also makes a reference to the BIS Certification Marking of the product. Details of which are given in National Annex A.

For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test or analysis shall be rounded off in accordance with IS 2: 2022 'Rules for rounding off numerical values (*second revision*)'.
