NATIONAL FOREWORD

Attention is drawn to the possibility that some of the elements of this standard may be the subject of patent rights. The Bureau of Indian Standards shall not be held responsible for identifying any or all such patent rights.

For the purpose of deciding whether a particular requirement of this standard is complied with, the final value, observed or calculated, expressing the result of a test or analysis, shall be rounded off in accordance with IS 2: 2022 'Rules for rounding off numerical values (*second revision*)'. The number of significant places retained in the rounded off value should be the same as that of the specified value in this standard.

SCOPE

This International Standard establishes procedures for the analysis of failures that occur during the acceptance testing or operation of launch pad and integration site facilities, systems and equipment. The procedures define

the processes for investigating, analysing and identifying the probable causes of failures, and for developing corrective actions to preclude future failures.

The purpose of this International Standard is to provide

- rules for investigating, analysing and identifying the causes of failures,

- sufficient information so that corrective action may be implemented to prevent failure recurrence, and

— a uniform method for maintaining records of the findings of all failure causes so as to provide information for other failure investigations.
