

## Evaluation System at IGNTU

The University follows a semester system. Each programme comprises a certain number of courses that carry a specific number of credits. The credit system implies that students are evaluated throughout the duration of programme.

The process of continuous assessment translates the students' performance into marks, which is converted into a percentage range that corresponds to a 10-point grade scale, which in turn is represented as letter grade. The process helps the standardization of inevitable variations at the levels of student performance and teacher evaluation across different universities.

Internal Assessment (IA) is assigned 40 marks and the End Semester (ES) examination 60 marks. The 10 point relative scale of grade used for the purpose of evaluation is illustrated in the table given. The lowest passing grade is C and a candidate has to secure a minimum total of 40 marks in each course to secure a Pass in that course. A candidate who does not obtain 40 marks for IA and ES exam together shall be deemed to have failed in that course.

**SGPA=  $\frac{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained}}{\text{Total Credit of Concerned Semester}}$**

**CGPA=  $\frac{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) of all Semester}}{\text{Total Credit of all Semesters}}$**

**Conversion of SGPA/CGPA to Percentage:  
Equivalent Percentage of Marks = SGPA/CGPA X 10**

### Declaration of Division:

A candidate who has passed in all the courses of examinations of all Semesters taken together will be declared as "Passed". Such candidates may be awarded the division according to following criterion:

- i. First Division: CGPA 6.0 and above
- ii. Second Division: CGPA 5.0 and above but below 6.0
- iii. Third Division: CGPA 4.0 and above but below 5.0

### Important:

- i. Students should immediately check the personal details and bring any discrepancies to the notice of Exam Section.
- ii. Students should make sure that the papers mentioned in the grade card are those they have attempted.

## Grading System at IGNTU

The University follows a ten point grading scale (as given below) for evaluation of student's academic performance in the courses during the semester:

Marks Range	Letter Grade	Grade Point
90-100	O	10
80-89	A+	9
70-79	A	8
60-69	B+	7
50-59	B	6
40-49	C	5
Below 40	F	0

There is no rounding off either of the Semester Grade Point Average or Cumulative Grade Point Average or Final Grade Point Average at the end of each successive semester as well as at the end of the programme.

The CGPA obtained by the student shall be classified into following division:

<u>CGPA</u>	<u>Grade</u>
9.0 and above	O
8.0 and above but less than 9.0	A+
7.0 and above but less than 8.0	A
6.0 and above but less than 7.0	B+
5.0 and above but less than 6.0	B
4.0 and above but less than 5.0	C
Less than 4.0	F

For proper evaluation of student's academic standing, his/her performance in all the semesters including grade obtained in the dissertation, should be taken into consideration.
