**Declaration of Result:**

After appearing at the Examination of Fourth Semester the Candidates can be put in the following two categories.

- Passed:** A candidate who has passed in all courses of examinations of I, II, III & IV Semesters and obtained at least CGPA of 5.00
- Failed:** All the students who have not PASSED will be categorized as "FAILED". A candidate shall be considered to have PASSED Fourth Semester course, if he/she has obtained Grade E or P above in each subject of the Fourth Semester courses

**Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in IV sem.**

$$\text{SGPA} = \frac{\text{Total Credit of Concerned Semester}}{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in I, II, III \& IV Semesters}}$$

**Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in I, II, III & IV Semesters**

$$\text{CGPA} = \frac{\text{Total Credit of I to IV Semester}}{\text{Sum of (Credits X Grade Points) obtained in I, II, III \& IV Semesters}}$$

**NOTE:**

The SGPA and CGPA shall be computed up to 2 place of decimals (truncated at the second place)  
 The conversion formula for converting CGPA to the corresponding percentage of marks will be as follows:

$$X = 10 Y - 4.5$$

Where, X = Percentage of Marks

Y = CGPA

**Declaration of Division:**

A candidate who has passed in all the courses of examinations of I, II, III & IV Semesters taken together will be declared as "Passed". Such passed candidates may be awarded with the division according to the following criterion:

- First Division with distinction.....CGPA 8.5 and above
- First Division.....CGPA 6.5 and above but below 8.5
- Second Division.....CGPA 5.00 and above but below 6.5.

**IMPORTANT**

Immediately after receipt of Grade-Card, candidates are advised to verify and ensure that: (a) the name, roll number and enrolment number have been correctly written; (b) the Grades have been entered against the subjects offered / appeared; (c) the total Credits mentioned at the bottom are correct; and (d) there is no overwriting or erasing.

In the event of any inaccuracy / discrepancy in regard to any of the above, they are advised to inform the Controller of Examinations, B.H.U. *within a week of the receipt of Grade-Card.*
