Declaration of Result:

After appearing at the Examination of Fourth Semester the Candidates can be put in the following two categories.

Passed: A candidate who has passed in all courses of examinations of I, II, III & IV Semesters and obtained at least CGPA of 5.00

Failed: All the students who have not PASSED will be categorized as "FAILED" A candidate shall be considered to have PASSED Fourth Semester course, if he/she has obtained Grade E or P above in each subject of the Fourth Semester courses

Declaration of Division:

(ii) First Division......CGPA 6.5 and above but below 8.5

(ii) Second Division......CGPA 5.00 and above but below 6.5.
