* Quality Certificate

The BIS has granted the quality certificate to Swachh Bharat Mission. This certificate helps us to ensure that the organisation will efficiently and effectively use the resources allotted them.

* Standards for disinfectant fluids

The BIS has published an Indian Standard (IS) for disinfectant fluids that classify them in two categories / types : White and Black. Each type then graded based on its germicidal properties.

* Sustainable packaging

The BIS has published an Indian Standard for Sustainable packaging in areas such as consumer products, food products, biodegradable plastic, compostable plastic, industrial paper and more.

* Air filters

The BIS has published an Indian Standard for Air filters to the air elements in general ventilation and dust in air. This Indian Standard ensures the freshness of air.
