

Summary of IS 1848 (Part 2):2018

This standard was first published in 1961 and subsequently revised in 1971, 1981, 1991 and 2007 with the title 'Writing and Printing Papers'. The standard was revised again in 2018 with splitting into two parts based on applications of varieties of papers.

Part 1 covers account book, azure laid, bond, cream laid and cream wove/printing white/printing coloured/printing offset, printing maplitho, printing white super calendered and typewriting varieties of writing and printing papers.

In Part 2, Air mail/manifold, Cartridge drawing, Cartridge white, Duplicating absorbent and duplicating semiabsorbent and Poster machine glazed varieties of writing and printing papers are covered.

This standard prescribes requirements, methods of sampling, tests, packing and marking for the varieties covered in Part 2. In addition, optional requirements for labelling environment friendly products with ECO-Mark as instructed by Ministry of Environment and Forests and Climate Change, Government of India have been specified.
