**Vitreous Sanitary Appliances (Vitreous China) –**  
**Requirements For Squatting Pans**

**Vitreous China Squatting Pans** being widely used type of **toilet** fixture in **India** in both public and private **restrooms/lavatories**, we expect it to be of better quality for effective functionality and longevity.

**Indian Standard IS 2556 (Part 3)**, developed by **Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS)**, outlines the quality requirements for vitreous china squatting pans.

This standard ensures squatting pan has appropriate **ergonomic design** and **dimensions/size**, optimum level of **glaze** and **surface finish**, resistant to **chemicals**, staining and burning, **load bearing capacity**, resistant to impact, meets specified **water holding capacity** and **flushing**.

As vitreous squatting pans serves as a practical and accessible **sanitary** solution that combines health benefits, cultural relevance, and environmental responsibility, By meeting requirements of Indian Standard, squatting pans manufactured according to IS 2556 (Part 3) ensure a high standard of **quality, durability, hygiene, and safety**, making them reliable and efficient for both public and private sanitation facilities.
