

<u>Indian Standard IS 2556 (Part 3): 2024</u> <u>Vitreous Sanitary Appliances (Vitreous China) – Requirements For Squatting Pans</u>

Vitreous China Squatting Pans being widely used type of toilet fixture in India in both public and private restrooms/lavatories, we expect it to be of better quality for effective functionality and longevity.

Indian Standard IS 2556 (Part 3), developed by Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), outlines the quality requirements for vitreous china squatting pans.

This standard ensures squatting pan has appropriate **ergonomic design** and **dimensions/size**, optimum level of **glaze** and **surface finish**, resistant to **chemicals**, staining and burning, **load bearing capacity**, resistant to impact, meets specified **water holding capacity** and **flushing**.

As vitreous squatting pans serves as a practical and accessible **sanitary** solution that combines health benefits, cultural relevance, and environmental responsibility, By meeting requirements of Indian Standard, squatting pans manufactured according to IS 2556 (Part 3) ensure a high standard of **quality**, **durability**, **hygiene**, **and safety**, making them reliable and efficient for both public and private sanitation facilities.
