**“Sheeting, Ticking’s and Bedsheets —**  
**Specification”**

Sheeting refers to fabric that is used as a base material for making bed linens, typically sold in rolls . Sheeting fabrics are made from materials like cotton, polyester, or cotton-polyester blends, and they are primarily used for making bedsheets, pillow covers, and other bedding products.

Ticking is a type of fabric used for covering mattresses and pillows. It is a strong, tightly woven fabric, often made from cotton or cotton blends, and may have a striped pattern or plain design. The primary function of ticking fabric is to enclose the filling material in mattresses and pillows to prevent the filling from spilling out.

Bedsheets are the finished products made from sheeting fabric. They are designed to cover mattress.

When consumers purchase these products , they have specific expectations regarding the quality, durability, comfort, and safety of these products.

IS 175 prescribes constructional details and other particulars like performance and dimensional requirements of sheeting, ticking’s and bedsheets, scoured, bleached, dyed or printed.

The standard does not specify general appearance, feel shade, etc.
