IS 15566: 2005 TEXTILES — CARAVAN AWNINGS — FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND TEST METHODS

An awning is a roof like cover extending over or in front of a place (as over the deck or in front of a door or window) as a shelter.

A Caravan Awning as defined in this IS 15566: 2005 'TEXTILES — CARAVAN AWNINGS — FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND TEST METHODS' means a 'Tent attached to a leisure accommodation vehicle to extend its living area'.

A good caravan awning should be durable, provide weather protection, be easy to set up, fit properly, offer versatility, have aesthetic appeal, and ensure adequate ventilation. These features collectively enhance the comfort and functionality of the camping experience.

The different types of Caravan Awning defined in IS 15566 : 2005 are Type SN, Type R, and Type T.

This Indian Standards specifies the requirements of the Awning Dimensions, Zip Fasteners, Awning Frame, Guying and Anchorage, Metallic Parts, Environmental Ventilation, Draught Exclusions, Window Cover, Rain-Resistance, Accessories, Instructions for Use, and Marking, thereby meeting the general requirements of the product.
